*Please note that classes may be cancelled if there are not enough students registered. Notification would include other class options if this should occur. Please note Kindergarten's minimum number of students is 8.

FYI: Maryland State Department of Education Textbook Grant : Because we participate in this grant, we are able to hold the tuition rates the same for two years. After that bi-yearly timeframe, the tuition is raised by a modest amount. We are able to do this because we do not need to budget for books, textbooks, and materials that we would normally need to purchase on a yearly basis.

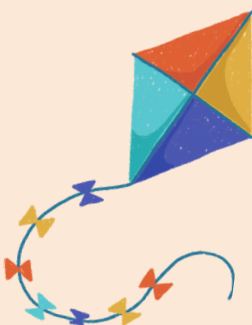

Admission

The Preschool & Kindergarten Program is in operation September through May following the calendar of the Carroll County Public Schools as much as possible. Enrollment is open to students meeting the age requirements for the class for which they are applying; a child must be 2,3,4 or 5 years old respectively, on or before September 1. The required forms for admission are an application form and Maryland Immunization Certificate which become part of the child's cumulative record. The registration process is completed when these forms and the registration fee have been returned by the date indicated on the application form. Active Presbyterian Church members' children and siblings of current students have priority for enrollment until December 1st. After that point, classes are available on a first come—first serve basis. Other applicants receive priority as of the date they preregister or are placed on a waiting list. You are invited to call the preschool office for more information or to make an appointment for a visit! Pre-registration begins October 1st.
